#### Water Tender Truck Chassis/Expenditure Approval:

Chief Campbell reported to Commissioners that they were able to locate a Kenworth T800 and will at the same time trade in the 94 Ford. He presented a handout to Commissioners that detailed the costs. After the trade-in the truck comes to \$46,000. Battalion Chief Jon Wisby will be driving to Indiana to purchase and trade in the trucks. They will work to complete the rest of the needed modifications to have the truck in service by spring.

#### Fire Chief

Chief Campbell presented the final 2018 Wildland Fire Season breakdown report. Brief discussion on the details of the season and the wrap up of all collected reimbursements.

Chief Campbell also reported that interviews for the new career firefighter position have finished. They had a total of 46 applicants. They will inform the final hire and notify the remaining applicants tomorrow.
